





Who to teach?

The target profile of the students will be people of all ages who want to grasp the Turkish language to use occasionally in their daily lives in Turkish speaking countries.







What is the teaching scope?

The purpose of the course is to familiarize the students with audio, and written Turkish contexts by teaching the expressions, vocabulary and grammar necessary and raising their cultural awareness as well as teaching how to speak and write to cope with their daily needs.







Topics to teach

The topics to be taught will be as follows,

- meeting, greeting, farewells
- personal introductions
- introducing someone
- physical description
- formal informal neutral registers
- imperatives, (giving instructions etc.)
- asking and giving directions, in the classroom, (classroom instructions etc.)
- at the restaurant cafe, (ordering etc.)





Topics to teach

- at the bank (opening a bank account etc.)
- at shopping, (asking the price etc.)
- at the hospital, (describing condition etc.)
- at work, (telephoning, writing a mail etc.)
- at the government office,(filing a report etc.)
- in the kitchen, (recipes, cooking words etc.)
- social media (read and write comments listings etc.)





Turkish Levels

A1 Beginner - 40 hrs.

- 1 Can communicate at a simple level if the people with whom s/he is speaking speak slowly and clearly and are ready to help.
- 2 Can introduce her/himself or others, in this context, communicate through basic questions such as where s/he lives, who s/he knows, what s/he has, etc.
- 3 Can understand and use familiar, everyday expressions and very basic idioms to meet concrete needs.
- 4 Using a simple language, s/he can give information about her/his own background and close environment and meet instant needs.





Turkish Levels

A2 Elementary - 40 hrs.

- 1 Can communicate at a simple level by exchanging information directly on familiar, familiar topics.
- 2 Can understand basic idioms and phrases that are frequently used in personal, family, shopping, work and close circle matters.
- 3 Can convey the events and experiences; can talk about her/his dreams, hopes and wishes, briefly explain their views and plans with her/his reasons.
- 4 He/she can express himself/herself in line with his/her personal interests or on the subjects he/she knows through simple texts in which connections between ideas are created.





Turkish Levels B1 Pre-Int. - 40 hrs.

- 1 Can handle most situations when traveling, where the language is spoken.
- 2 Can understand the main lines of written and spoken expressions based on common and familiar topics in daily life, at work or at school.
- 3 Can express her/himself in a detailed and understandable way on different subjects and reflect her/his own point of view by revealing the positive and negative aspects of a subject.







Turkish Levels

B2 Intermediate - 40 hrs.

- 1 Can communicate with a native speaker using a certain natural and fluent language without much difficulty.
- 2 Can understand the main idea of complex texts based on abstract and concrete topics, and can conduct technical discussions on subjects in his/her field of expertise.
- 3 Can express her/himself fluently on complex topics through well-structured, detailed text with clear connections and relationships.







Turkish Levels

C1 Upper-Int. - 40 hrs.+

- 1 Can use the language flexibly and effectively for academic and professional purposes and in daily life.
- 2 Can express her/himself naturally and fluently, finding the expressions s/he needs without too much difficulty.
- 3 Can understand long and complex texts with different structures and recognize indirect expressions and implications in these texts.







How to teach?

The sessions will be based on context-based learning, incorporating fun and learning. The implementation of the course will be as follows,

- Visual stimulus
- Pre-teach vocabulary, phrases
- Modelling
- Role-plays
- Controlled practice
- Freer practice
- Feedback







Lesson Day & Hours

The suitable day and hours will be determined after negotiating with the students.

Availability is as follows;

Weekdays 5pm - 9pm Weekends 9am - 5pm







Lesson Materials

For the general of the lessons an up-to-date Turkish student's book and its workbook are used. The related materials will be uploaded as soft copy (PDF) on Google Classroom. Further handouts and printouts will be provided to support the lesson and homework assignment from different books and online sources.





Assessment & Feedback

Apart from formative assessments in each lesson, there will be progress tests and quizzes within certain periods to see the developments and if necessary there will be extra lessons for consolidation.







Student Agreement

1. Every student is responsible for their learning, therefore one must study regularly and do the assigned homework on time to meet the goals of the course.







Student Agreement

2. Lessons take place in 2-hour sessions. Sessions start with a tolerance of +- 5 minutes on the days and hours specified in the agreement and end on time. In online or face-to-face classes, if the student(s) is absent within 30 minutes, the session is considered to be done and therefore cancelled.







Student Agreement

3. The regular attendance of the students is highly advised and only in the event of a serious shortcoming (illness, meeting, ceremonies, etc.), the students are allowed to be absent.







Student Agreement

4. Rescheduling can be an option with a notice of at least 24 hrs. before the lesson. If the student fails to inform in the designated period, the student agrees to pay for the related sessions.







Student Agreement

5. The canceled hours due to the tutor will be compensated on an agreed day or will be added to the end of the arranged training period.







Student Agreement

6. In the case of dropping the course, the student agrees to pay for the related month's training fee.







Lesson fee

The lesson fee per hour will be as follows;

1-1 Student - 100 AED per hour / student

2-Student group - 85 AED per hour / student

3-Student group - 70 AED per hour / student

*4-Student group - 50 AED per hour / student

*Groups with 4 and more students are fixed to 50 AED per hour.







Payment Agreement

Payments will be made before the first lesson in accordance with the agreed payment plan.
